What it covers

Birth control, pregnancy tests and counseling, and health screenings and treatment for hypertension, diabetes and cholesterol.

HTW Plus Covers

- Postpartum depression and other mental health conditions
- Cardiovascular and coronary conditions
- Substance use disorders, including drug, alcohol, and tobacco misuse (services include screenings, brief interventions, treatment referrals, outpatient substance use counseling, smoking cessation services, medication-assisted treatment, and peer specialist services).

 - Weekly: Last **4** Check Stubs
 - Bi-Weekly: Last **2** Check Stubs
 - Cash: Employer Letter

Prenatal Medicaid/CHIP

What it covers

- Prenatal doctor visits.
- Prenatal vitamins.
- Labor and delivery.
- Checkups and other benefits for the baby after leaving the hospital

Required Documents

- ID
- Proof of Pregnancy
 - Clinical Proof
- Proof of Address
- Proof of Income
 - Weekly: Last **4** Check Stubs
 - Bi-Weekly: Last **2** Check Stubs
 - Cash: Employer Letter
